Signing in and out:

Please sign in at the Thomas Paine Study Centre and sign out in LSB 0.112.

LSB will be the main Student Guide area for the duration of the day. Once you have signed in with us, there will be a short briefing, then please go and find your area lead and sign in with them.

Lunchbreak:

You have been allocated a lunch break in your briefing email, the area lead also has this information, please double check with the area lead that they are happy for you to go at this time.

You will be given:

- A copy of the programme for the day so you can answer questions on talk locations and timings. This also includes a campus map with zoning information.

Your locations information:

Subjects based in the Queens Building Floor 2 are Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy and Speech and Language Therapy.

There are also Anatomy Suite tours in Queens which visitors interested in MED will be attending.

Other School locations can be found in your copy of the programme. Please make sure you refer to the programme at all times.

- You may be asked to give tours of the Queens Building – Sarah Drake will supply you with a tour route
- Taking visitors to talks/demos where required
- Collecting visitors from the subject talks/demos and guiding them to their next location
- Offering directions to other talks/demos and activities across campus
- Offering tours of the school facilities where relevant
- Answering questions about student life at UEA and your course
- A number of other duties may be asked of you during the day – please listen to staff in your area
