OPEN RESEARCH

Pure is a research information system that is used to hold data about the varied research, innovation and engagement activities that happen across UEA. Your Pure record feeds information about you to publicly accessible UEA sites, including the People Pages and the UEA digital repository.

PURE PROFILE AND PEOPLE PAGES

Data in your Pure profile is used to populate your People Page with details of publication lists, research data and profile information. Keeping your profile up-to-date helps to improve the visibility and discoverability of the different aspects of your research.

OPEN RESEARCH PUBLICATIONS

The People Pages display bibliographic details and the full text of research outputs entered in Pure. They indicate when outputs are open, how they are licensed, and can provide direct access to the full text. The digital repository helps ensure outputs meet open access policy requirements, including for REF2021.

OPEN RESEARCH DATA

Pure can be used to capture metadata on datasets and can also hold some types of research dataset that are not available from another repository. The dataset information on your People Page can also link to related research outputs.

ORCID

ORCID is a unique, persistent digital identifier that differentiates you from other researchers. Increasingly required by funders, it will also be requested for REF 2021. UEA researchers can create an ORCID in Pure (or link an existing ORCID to their Pure profile) and populate their ORCID profile with data held in Pure.
