Response to Environmental Information Regulations 2004 request (EIR_16-098)

I am requesting information that the UEA holds in regard to “the boiler house roof” space on top of the maintenance building formerly used for parking.

Please provide the details of who owns this land and if not known the details of the managing agent.

This land is owned by the University of East Anglia.

Please provide a copy of the contract between yourselves and National Parking Enforcement Ltd (Trading previously as Norfolk Parking Enforcement Limited) that authorises them to erect signage and issue parking charges with regard to persons who park on this parcel of land.

The University does not have a contract with National Parking Enforcement Ltd. There is instead a ‘form of permission’ which enables NPE to provide private parking enforcement on UEA land.

If no contract exists, please list the relationship(s) between yourselves and others including but not limited to, the private parking company and land owner, with regard to the management / leasing of this parcel of land.

NPE have permission to provide parking enforcement on the private land, roadways and car parks belonging to the University of East Anglia. This agreement is on a continual rolling basis. There are currently no other relationships between UEA and other parties relating to the management or leasing of this land.
