The Norfolk Gardens Trust Tate Award

Eligibility

1. To be eligible for this Award, applicants must:
 - a. Be currently enrolled on the MA Landscape History degree course in the School of History.
 - b. Be undertaking a study into an aspect of Norfolk garden or designed landscape history.

Value of award

2. The value of the Award is £1,500 which will be awarded towards the recipient's tuition fees or as a grant payment.

Selection process

3. The Award will be awarded by a Selection Committee whose decision is final.
4. The recipient will be chosen based on their:
 - a. Academic history.
 - b. Potential for further academic progress.
 - c. When considering applications, the Committee may give preference to applicants who have had their study disrupted by extenuating circumstances.¹

Award terms

5. If two candidates are judged to be of sufficient and equal merit, the Award may be divided. There will be a maximum of two winners each year.
6. If no candidate is judged to be of sufficient merit, or there are no eligible candidates, the Award will not be awarded.
7. The recipient will be required to give a presentation to the Norfolk Gardens Trust on the findings of their research at the Norfolk Gardens Trust AGM.
8. The recipient will be required to produce an article about their work to be published in the Norfolk Gardens Trust Newsletter.

¹ Extenuating circumstances will be considered on a case-by-case basis by the Selection Committee.
