- The figures above relate to staff working on WP issues in the University's Admissions, Recruitment and Marketing team, which was formed in 2011-12. Before this point, staff working on WP projects were distributed in a number of different areas of the University, and we do not hold figures on how many staff were working only on WP issues.
- The figures show those staff employed to undertake Outreach (Access) work, not all WP work (which includes retention and success projects with current undergraduate students). Staff in other University departments may also work on WP projects, but are not part of a specific WP team and may also have other roles at the University.

We hope this information will meet your requirements, however if you are not satisfied you have the right of appeal.
