Response to Freedom of Information Act 2000 request (FOI_17-145)

We would like to benchmark the value of the Nursing and Midwifery, and Allied Health Profession PGT courses to future healthcare workforce. In particular we are keen to better understand the profile of retention and completion within these subject areas, as this information is not available via central sources (such as HEIDI Plus). To this end, we look for your help in providing a robust sample size with the following data requests:

- 1. The latest 3 academic years of data the HEI is willing to provide (ideally 14/15, 15/16, 16/17)*
- 2. By course of study/programme*
- 3. By mode of attendance*
- 4. Headcount of new students registering onto the programme*
- 5. Headcount of students completing/graduating from their study*
- 6. Headcount of students withdrawn from the programme*
- 7. Excluding students studying on Continuous Professional Development pathways*
