We have now considered your request of 07 August 2017 as clarified on 11 August for the following information:

'1) The number of British (of African or Caribbean descent, mixed black or black other) students that are currently enrolled in or have graduated with a B.A. in any Japanese studies or Japanese language related course (single or joint honours).

2) Data on the number of British (of African or Caribbean descent, mixed black or black other) students that are currently enrolled in or have graduated with an MA (taught) in any Japanese studies or Japanese language related course (single or joint honours).

3) Data on the number of British (of African or Caribbean descent, mixed black or black other) students that are currently enrolled in or have graduated with a Research Degree (MPhil or PhD) in any Japanese studies or Japanese language related course (single or joint honours).'

[Clarified on 11 August to require for questions 2 and 3 only the numbers of enrolled and graduated as far back as this data is available, and to request that the data be presented separating the number of currently enrolled with the number of graduates, and categorized by their specific programme]
