How much money has the university gained from parking on the university campus per year in 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016?

How much money does the university charge per hour to park on the university campus?

How much money does the university charge for a full day of parking on the university campus?

The various parking charges for different users and locations are available from the above links. Car park users may use more than one parking option in any 24-hour period.

Does the university offer a permit for students? If yes, how much does the university charge for a permit, and how long does this permit last?

The University does not charge for permits but does have a daily charge for permit holders (see above).

Students are only eligible for a permit where there are extenuating welfare needs, or on a temporary basis to cover for periods of placement. Parking charges are shown on the website above.

Permits are generally valid for a year but may be given for longer in certain circumstances, for example, where there is a long-term disability.

Does the university charge disabled people to park on the university campus?

Yes, the rate for a person with a disability is the same as for other car park users.
