Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Information request (ref: FOI_18-026)

We have now considered your request of 30 January 2018 as clarified on 21 February for the following information:

- 1) *'Breakdown of enrolled first-year undergraduate students, sorted by primary nationality, for the academic years 2008/2009 to 2013/2014 included, in total number and in percentage over first-year student body, by Subject, as well as the total number of enrolled first-year undergraduate students by nationality in the University.*
[Clarified on 21 February to limit questions 1, 2, & 3 to undergraduate students enrolled in full-time courses]
- 2) *Breakdown of applicants to undergraduate degrees (four-year Master's degrees and similar included), sorted by primary nationality, for the academic years 2008/2009 to 2013/2014 included, in total number and in percentage over total number of applicants, by Subject, as well as the total number of applicants to such degrees by nationality in the University.*
- 3) *Data on the means of payment of tuition fees of first-year undergraduate students from the EU, including UK, sorted by nationality - in particular, I request information on the amount of students relying on student loans or studentships as compared to those who fully support themselves on personal means. I request this data broken down by Subject, as well as the total data for all first-year undergraduate students in the University, for the same years specified above.'*

Our response is within the attached documents entitled FOI_18-026 Appendix A and FOI_18-026 Appendix B. Appendix A contains the data broken down by subject and nationality and Appendix B contains the total data information requested. Please accept our apologies for the delay in forwarding our response to you.

In order to ensure that we do not inadvertently release personal data, in this response or in combination with other publicly available data, we have, in response to each question, replaced all values between 1 and 4 in relation to the number of students or applicants with the value '<5'.

As we have not as yet received a response to our further request for clarification on 26 February, please note that, for the purposes of this request, we have interpreted 'Subject' to be equivalent to an academic School of Study within our University.

Finally, within the response to question 1 within Appendix A we have a subject category of 'INTO' which represents UEA students who, at the time, had progressed from INTO University Partnerships location in Norwich¹ to UEA but had not been assigned to a School of Study within our records.

We hope this information will meet your requirements, however if you are not satisfied you have the right of appeal. If you wish to appeal, please set out in writing your reasons for appealing and send to the above address. You must appeal within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. Any appeal received after that date will not be considered nor acknowledged. This policy has been reviewed and approved by the Information Commissioner's Office.
