1) Could you please provide me with the number of candidates who sat finals (Finals A, B and C) for the medicine A100 course and the number of these who passed on a) The first attempt, and b) at re-sit in the same academic year. Could I please have this information for the last 5 years.

Our response is provided in the table below.

	2012/13	2013/14	2014/15	2015/16	2016/17
Students who sat finals	154	135	124	136	144
Passed at first attempt	138	126	118	112	131
Passed at re-sit	15	8	6	21	10

Please note that the figures above include some students who commenced an A104 course and then were re-coded as A100 students. Such students would also be included in the figures given in response to question 2 below.

2) Could you please tell me the number of A104 medicine students who have successfully graduated from Norwich Medical School? If possible, could you also please state how many of these candidates completed the course in over 6 years? Could I please have this information for the last 5 years.

Our response is provided in the table below. Please note that students can graduate with one of four awards¹ so we have provided the total number of students that graduated with any award and those that graduated with the Degree of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Science.
