We have now considered your request of 19 March 2018 for information relating to the number of students and financial data relating to the three main types of TNE/offshore education provision.

Our response is on page 2 of this letter, together with a copy of your request.

On this occasion it is not possible to provide all the requested information. In line with your rights under section 1(1)(a) of the Act to be informed whether information is held, we confirm that the University does not hold information on TNE expenditure for 2007/08. This is due to the fact that formal financial records are only held, as per the University's records retention policy, for 7 years.

We hope this information will meet your requirements, however if you are not satisfied you have the right of appeal.
