**Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Information request (ref: FOI\_18-233)**

We have now considered your request of 22 September 2018 for the following information:

*'A copy of the academic score grid used to rank applicants for 2019 entry together with the cut-off and average score for 2018 entry. If possible could the average score for 2018 entry be separated by fee status as well?'*

Our response is as follows:

On this occasion it is not possible to provide all the requested information. In line with your rights under section 1(1)(a) of the Act to be informed whether information is held, we confirm that the University does not hold a scoring sheet or grid for 2019 entry, neither do we hold average scores for overseas applicants for 2018 entry. There is also no cut-off score for 2018 entries.

With regard to the remaining part of your request, the average academic score for 2018 entries was 15.97. The average score for UK applicants was 16.09 and for EU applicants the average was 14.31.

We hope this information will meet your requirements, however if you are not satisfied you have the right of appeal. If you wish to appeal, please set out in writing your reasons for appealing and send to the above address. You must appeal within 40 working days of the date of this letter. Any appeal received after that date will not be considered nor acknowledged. This policy has been reviewed and approved by the Information Commissioner's Office.
