We have now considered your request of 03 October 2018 for the following information:

*'I would like to request the information for the MBBS Medicine course. Please provide me an excel sheet with the following information for each of the two latest admissions cycle for the course: UKCAT score, A level subject grade predicted, Interviewed/non interviewed, Made an offer/ not made an offer and Enrolled/applicant declined offer/applicant did not meet offer'*

Our response is held within the accompanying spreadsheet, 'FOI\_18-242 Appendix A'.

On this occasion it is not possible to provide some of the requested information. In line with your rights under section 1(1)(a) of the Act to be informed whether information is held, we confirm that the University does not hold some of the information requested. Against applicants where the status is 'No A level predictions provided' there were no A level subject grades (predicted) provided by the applicant, and not all UKCAT scores were held by the University.

If you wish to appeal, please set out in writing your reasons for appealing and send to the above address. You must appeal within 40 working days of the date of this letter.
