Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Information request (ref: FOI_18-244)

We have now considered your request of 05 October 2018 for the following information:

'I would like to receive the point allocation system used to rank applicants [to the University's Medical School], as well as the likely cut-off for the 2018 admissions cycle (2019 entry). Additionally, I would like to know how the situational judgment and personal statement will be used.'

Our response is as follows:

On this occasion it is not possible to provide all the requested information. In line with your rights under section 1(1)(a) of the Act to be informed whether information is held, we confirm that the University does not hold a point allocation system, scoring sheet or grid for this purpose. There is also no cut-off score for this cycle.

In answer to the second part of your request, the Situational Judgement component score is included within the interview score. The personal statement is read by one of the interviewers who is participating in the multi mini interview station, prior to the interview. We hope this information will meet your requirements, however if you are not satisfied you have the right of appeal.
