## Response to Freedom of Information Act 2000 request (FOI\_18-152)

*I believe that there are teachers in your medical schools/colleges/institutions in the non-clinical subjects of Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pharmacology and Microbiology who are not doctors (with an MBBS degree) but hold postgraduate degree in science (such as M.Sc) or doctorate (Ph.D) who are engaged in the UG teaching.*

*It would be very useful to us if you could kindly provide the names and qualifications of such "non-medical" teachers in all of the recognized medical institutions under your university.*

We have identified 27 individuals who teach the listed subjects within the Norwich Medical School. Of those, we have identified 8 which do not possess a MBBS degree and they are listed in the table below with a link to the relevant 'person page' on our website that gives details of their qualifications.
