Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Information request (ref: FOI_18-062)

We have now considered your request of 08 March 2018 for the following information:

“I am contacting all UK schools of pharmacy to ask how many hours are students given as delivered content on ocular conditions throughout the undergraduate programme?”

Our response is as follows:

On the MPHarm course at UEA undergraduate students currently receive the following teaching in relation to ocular conditions:

In year 4, within the Central Nervous System, Neurodegenerative Disease and Mental Health module, they receive 2 hours of lectures on glaucoma.

In year 2 within the Neurophysiology, Synaptic Pharmacology and Endocrinology module, they receive a 1 hour lecture on ocular pharmacology, a 1 hour workshop on ocular pharmacology and a 3 hour practical on vision.

Conjunctivitis will be mentioned whenever it is a symptom of an infection or disease but this is not quantifiable throughout the course or within any particular module.

We hope this information will meet your requirements, however if you are not satisfied you have the right of appeal. If you wish to appeal, please set out in writing your reasons for appealing and send to the above address. You must appeal within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. Any appeal received after that date will not be considered nor acknowledged. This policy has been reviewed and approved by the Information Commissioner’s Office.
