Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Information request (ref: FOI_18-080)

We have now considered your request of 23 March 2018 for the following information:

'Most basically we are interested in discovering what percentage of students taking specific crime writing courses are women. Do you have more female students than male students... or not...'

Our response is as follows:

There are a total of 18 female students currently registered on the specific crime writing course at UEA, the part-time taught postgraduate MA Creative Writing Crime Fiction course.¹ With a total number of registered students on the course of 26, this gives a percentage of 69% that are female.

In relation to the other 'non-FOIA' questions in your request of 23 March, we suggest you contact the convenor of this course, Mr Henry Sutton, Senior Lecturer in Creative Writing.²

We hope this information will meet your requirements, however if you are not satisfied you have the right of appeal. If you wish to appeal, please set out in writing your reasons for appealing and send to the above address. You must appeal within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. Any appeal received after that date will not be considered nor acknowledged. This policy has been reviewed and approved by the Information Commissioner's Office.
