We have now considered your request of 11 July 2018 for information relating to degree classifications awarded by UEA.

Our response is on page 2 of this letter, together with a copy of your request.

On this occasion it is not possible to provide all the requested information. In line with your rights under section 1(1)(a) of the Act to be informed whether information is held, we confirm that the University does not hold information on the number or percentage of 'Pass' classifications awarded. This is due to the fact that this classification did not exist and therefore could not be awarded by UEA for years requested.

We hope this information will meet your requirements, however if you are not satisfied you have the right of appeal.
