Response to Freedom of Information Act 2000 request (FOI_18-154)

1. The number of registered students with a visual impairment

UEA holds recorded information identifying 10 current students as being registered with a visual impairment. It should be noted that this number simply reflects those individuals who have formally identified themselves as having a visual impairment.

2. The number of students are text to speech users

Any student registered at UEA may use text to speech technology. However, we can confirm that four (4) current students have had text to speech software recommended to them, either formally via a Needs Assessment Report or informally by a University Disability Advisor.

3. The number of students are screen reader users

Any student registered at UEA may use screen reader technology. We can confirm that no (0) current students have had screen reader software recommended to them either formally via a Needs Assessment Report or informally by a Disability Advisor.

4. The total number of students

There are 16,966 current students registered at UEA.
