Discussion

This year, the decision was taken to keep the theme of the event as open as possible and the structure such that it allowed for the greatest number/variety of examples of practice to be showcased. With this in mind, we have called the Day *Show and Tell*. The *Tell* aspect of the day will be a range of short (15 minute) papers delivered in parallel sessions; the *Show* part of the day will be a curated exhibition of 'teaching artefacts' – e.g virtual reality equipment (CHE), anatomy dummies (MED), interactive software - to be housed in the foyer and downstairs rooms of TPSC. Again, the key aim is to showcase the widest variety of good teaching practice across the University and to stimulate colleagues in their own thinking about teaching. In addition, the University teaching fellows will be delivering a group session after lunch to demonstrate their own contributions to the vibrant culture of teaching and learning at UEA.
