1. QUALITY ENHANCEMENT AND DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITY

1.1 Academic Partnerships Conference

The second annual Partnerships conference, which was due to be held on 1 March, was postponed due to weather and travel conditions. The event has been rearranged for 6 July 2018 at INTO UEA.

1.2 Office for Students Registration

Academic Partnerships are undertaking a number of activities to support partners in their registration with the Office for Students. Support has been tailored to specific partners but has included producing guidance materials, membership of implementation groups and facilitating of webinars.
