Environmental Information Regulations 2004 – Information request (ref: EIR_19-075)

We have now considered your request of 11 March 2019 for the following information:

'Has asbestos been reported on the university estate in 2018 and 2019?'

We have received no reply to our email of 12 March, in which we requested clarification of your request, therefore we are responding on the grounds that we believe you are asking if any RIDDOR (Reporting of Injuries Diseases or Dangerous Occurrences Regulations) reportable incidents involving Asbestos were recorded for 2018 and 2019.

Our response is as follows:

The University had no (RIDDOR) reportable incidents on site in 2018 or 2019.

We hope this information will meet your requirements, however if you are not satisfied you have the right of appeal. If you wish to appeal, please set out in writing your reasons for appealing and send to the above address. You must appeal within 40 working days of the date of this letter. In line with section 5.3 of the UK Government's Freedom of Information Act Code of Practice, we are not obliged to accept internal reviews after this date.
