Thank you for your request of 16 December 2019 for the following information:

‘Project Name: The Quadram Institute

Location: Colney Lane, Colney, Norwich, Norfolk, NR4 7UA

Under the Freedom of information act 2000 please can you send me an up to date list of all contractors, sub-contractors and suppliers that have been working on the construction of “The Quadram Institute“;’ Scheme comprises construction of building for research and medical uses and discharge of conditions 12, 14, 15, 16, 19, 21, and 24 pursuant to Outline 2012/1880. The associated works include sewer systems, enabling and access roads.’

On this occasion it is not possible to provide the requested information. In line with your rights under section 1(1)(a) of the Act to be informed whether information is held, we confirm that the University does not hold any of the information requested. The University was not involved in the construction of the Quadram Institute, therefore we do not hold any information on the contractors, sub-contractors or suppliers used.

We believe this information is likely to be held by the Biotechnology and Biological Sciences Research Council (BBSRC) as they were responsible for this work and your request would be better directed to the BBSRC for response. We are sorry we cannot provide the data you requested, but trust this letter explains our position. If you are unhappy with our response, you have the right of appeal against this decision.
