Freedom of Information Act 2000– Information request (ref: FOI_19-047)

We have now considered your request of 17 January 2019 as amended on 13 February for the following information:

'I am looking for some information about your undergraduate law course. In particular, I would like to find out the distribution of classifications upon graduation per cohort (e.g. how many law students who graduated in 2017/18 achieved a 1st, 2.1 etc).

If you were able to share the distribution of results at module level per cohort as well that would also be something we would be interested in (e.g. how many students who graduated in 2017/18 achieved a 70-100, 60-69 etc for each course module).

It would be good to see the most recent stats, as well as any information going back the past few academic years if possible.'

Thank you for your email of 13 February in which you noted you would accept only the overall degree classification breakdown for students who graduated in 2016, 2017 and 2018. We are providing only this information as we were concerned that providing the module-level data would risk revealing personal data, as defined by the General Data Protection Regulation, and as a result some of the module level data would either be masked or exempted from release in any case.

Therefore, our response to the amended request is in the table below:

We hope this information will meet your requirements, however if you are not satisfied you have the right of appeal.
