We have now considered your request of 11 July 2019 and clarification email of 12 July 2019 for information relating to INTO UEA student deaths and the deaths of students at UEA who were previously registered with INTO.

Our response is on page 2 of this letter, together with a copy of your request.

On this occasion it is not possible to provide all the requested information. In line with your rights under section 1(1)(a) of the Act to be informed whether information is held, we confirm that the University does not hold information relating to the number deaths of students registered with INTO at the time of their death. Further information is on page 2 of this letter

We hope this information will meet your requirements, however if you are not satisfied you have the right of appeal. If you wish to appeal, please set out in writing your reasons for appealing and send to the above address. You must appeal within 40 working days of the date of this letter. In line with section 5.3 of the UK Government's Freedom of Information Act Code of Practice, we are not obliged to accept internal reviews after this date.

Response to Freedom of Information Act 2000 request (FOI_19-207)

How many INTO UEA student deaths have there been in the last five years (2014/15 to the present day), and if possible what were the reasons or cause of death?

[Clarification received on 12 July 2019:

I'm looking for students who were registered with INTO at the time of their death for each academic year.

If possible it would be interesting to see the information as well, separately, for students who were registered with INTO and then went on to UEA who died while in attendance at UEA.]

[Information not held - s.1(1)(a), Freedom of Information Act

INTO UEA is not part of the University, and therefore is not subject to the Freedom of Information Act. The University is not obligated to respond to requests regarding INTO on their behalf, and we would suggest that contact be made directly with INTO to obtain information from them.

We can, however, provide a response to the second part of your request, and can confirm that from 2014-15 to date the number of deaths of students who were registered with INTO and who died whilst in attendance the UEA, is zero.
