'Please confirm whether your University holds information on the number of alumni that accessed the following services, for each academic year, from 2013/14. And, if confirmed, please release this figure:

- s.) *Careers counselling service*
- t.) *A CV and/or cover letter clinic (or similar service)*
- u.) *Assistance with additional materials for an application (non CV or cover letter documents that may be required for an application)*
- v.) *A one-to-one discussion with an advisor over a particular job application (specific to a role)*
- w.) *A remote service for advice on documents required for a particular role (which does not require the individual to attend in person)*
- x.) *Any scheme which links students to an individual (whether alumni or other) with specific knowledge of the industry to which a specific job application pertains'*

We do hold figures for alumni who have accessed the services listed above for each academic year since 2013-14, and have provided those figures in the table below:
