We have now considered your request of 15 October 2019 for the following information:

‘For the past five years up to the present day (2014/15-present day) how much money has the university paid to UEA students who have been the victims of data leaks at the university?’

Our response is as follows:

The University has paid no money to students. However, over the requested period, a total of £142,512.16 has been paid by our insurers.
