Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Information request (ref: FOI_19-183)

We have now considered your request of 02 July 2019 for the following information:

'We have conducted a study to find out how many people say they would donate their bodies, which found that 17% of people in the UK say they would. However, we imagine that the number of people who actually do donate their bodies to medical research each year is much lower than that. Would it be possible for us to obtain the number of donations you received in 2018 and 2017?'

Our response is as follows:

In 2017 we accepted 17 body donors from 70 offers.

In 2018 we accepted 23 body donors from 63 offers.

We hope this information will meet your requirements, however if you are not satisfied you have the right of appeal. If you wish to appeal, please set out in writing your reasons for appealing and send to the above address. You must appeal within 40 working days of the date of this letter. In line with section 5.3 of the UK Government's Freedom of Information Act Code of Practice, we are not obliged to accept internal reviews after this date.
