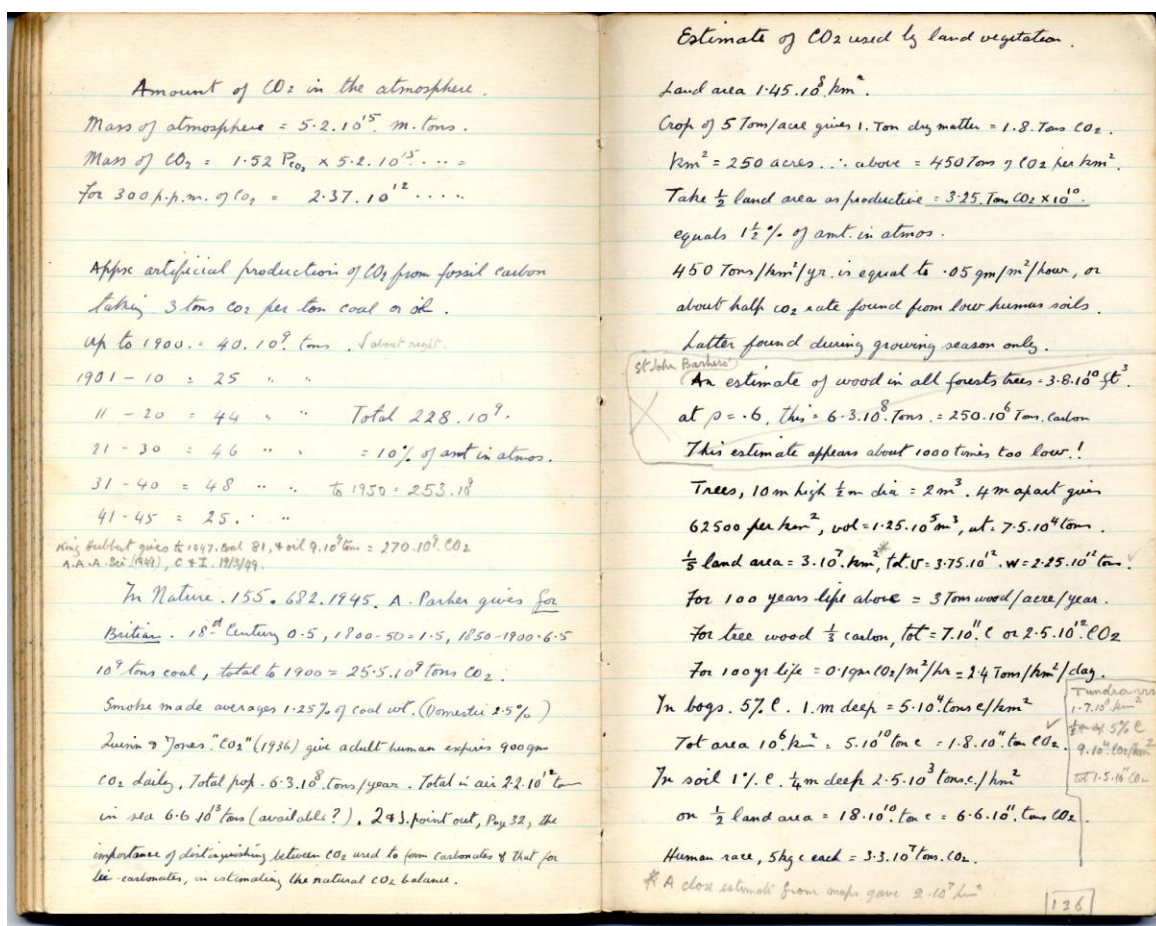


G.S. CALLENDAR'S NOTEBOOKS.

Guy Callendar's notebook on CO₂, 1939-1940

Guy Stewart Callendar (1898-1964), a noted steam engineer and amateur meteorologist, collected weather data from frontier stations around the world and revived the carbon dioxide theory of climate change.
