We have now considered your request of 03 November 2015 for the following information:

*‘Do you pay for journals from any of the institutions listed below? What is the price for each of the journals that you pay?’*

- *British Medical Ultrasound Society (Ultrasound)*
- *British Nuclear Medicine Society (Nuclear Medicine Communications)*
- *The Society for Radiological Protection*
- *British Institute of Radiology (British Journal of Radiology)*
- *Institute of Physics & Engineering in Medicine (Physics in Medicine & Biology, Medical Engineering & Physics, Physiological Measurement)’*

Our response is as follows:

The University receives four relevant journals:

- Journal of the Society for Radiological Protection
- Physics in Medicine & Biology
- Physiological Measurement
- Medical Engineering & Physics

We receive these journals via subscription with the Institute of Physics (first three titles listed) and Elsevier B.V. (final title).

These subscriptions cover a number of journals, and we pay one overall fee for each subscription - the cost per title is not specified. Therefore, in line with your rights under section 1(1)(a) of the Act to be informed whether information is held, we confirm that the University does not hold information on the cost of each of these journals.

We hope this information meets your requirements, however you have the right of appeal against this response. If you wish to appeal, please set out in writing your reasons for appealing and send to the above address. You must appeal within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. Any appeal received after that date will not be considered nor acknowledged. This policy has been reviewed and approved by the Information Commissioner’s Office.
