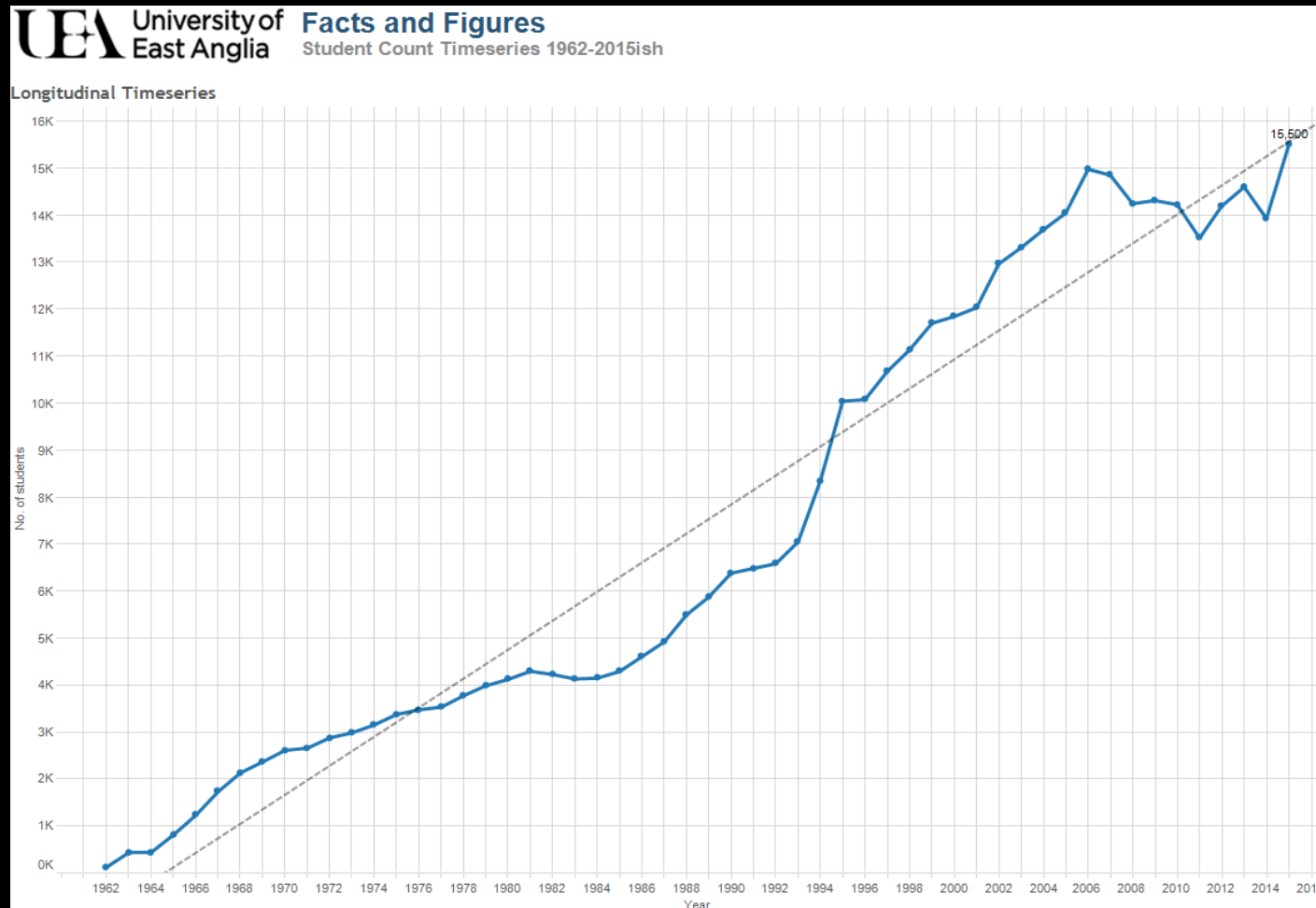

Research Excellence Framework 2014

- Over 70 per cent of the University's research activity was deemed to be world leading or internationally excellent with 99% in total being of international standing
- Ranked =10th in UK for quality of research publications

149th in THE World University Rankings (2015)

Top 5 for student satisfaction amongst mainstream English universities every year since the National Student Survey began in 2005
