6.2 Changes Clarifying the Regulations on the Capping of Reassessment Marks

At the Joint Committee meeting on 9 December 2009 it was agreed that as there had been confusion regarding capping of marks following reassessment, instruction 7.1.1.c, which does not apply to these courses, has been removed from the Instructions to Examiners for the Degree of Bachelor of Arts and Diploma of Higher Education in Professional Practice.

The section removed from the Instructions to Examiners reads:

Where the actual mark achieved in the Reassessment is above the pass mark, a mark capped at the pass mark shall be recorded against the module in question for use in the Final.
