The Faculty LTQC wishes to bring the following issues to the attention of LTC

All courses are of high quality and have been consistently praised by external examiners. The following issues are particularly noteworthy:

- **Employability:**

Schools have introduced modules and extra-curricular activities to strengthen student employability. Examples are the 'Translation Work Experience' module in LCS, internships in LDC and the in MA Landscape History in HIS which teaches practical skills.

- Schools attract high calibre students (LDC and HIS are particularly successful).

- Part-time courses provide flexibility and attract mature students.

- MA courses are important feeders for PhD programmes (see in particular HIS), but Schools have been asked to consider more carefully the needs of those students who do not wish to pursue further postgraduate studies.

- **Further development of courses:**

LCS has secured funding for a lectureship in Japanese and Honours Japanese (from 2011/12), which demonstrates the success and reputation of the School.

- The communication between Schools over joint honours programmes could be improved. The new academic model has clear guidelines.

- PGT students could be represented better in some Schools. The introduction of a SSLC for PGT students and/or an increase in the number of PGT student representatives are possible solutions.
