Prizes for Distinguished Performance in Actuarial Science and Business Statistics

Four annual prizes are awarded by the Board of Examiners for Actuarial Science for distinguished performance in Actuarial Science and/or Business Statistics.

Rules

The following prizes may be awarded annually in the School of Computing Sciences:

1. One prize of £75 for distinguished performance in the Year 1 Assessment.
2. One prize of £100 for distinguished performance in the Year 2 Assessment.
3. One prize of £100 for distinguished performance in the Year 3 Assessment.
4. One prize of £100 for distinguished performance in the Final Year Assessment.
5. The prizes shall be awarded on the recommendation of the Board of Examiners concerned. If in any year no candidate is judged to be of sufficient merit in one of these categories, no prize shall be awarded; if two or more candidates are deemed to be of equal merit, the prize shall be divided or an additional prize awarded.
