## Final Report on MUS closure

### Undergraduates

The final cohort of 43 MUS students - plus 2 joint honours American Studies with Music - successfully completed their degrees in the summer of 2104. The final Good honours result was 90.7 against a target value of 91.5. This result broke down as –

- 7 MUS students at Class I
- 2 MUS/AMS students at Class I
- 32 at CLASS II, Division 1
- 3 at CLASS II, Division 2
- 1 at Class III

Three students obtained a Diploma.

Post closure generic references for all students are in place as requested by the Music Monitoring Committee.

A report on the use and result of the successful 2013/14 employability fund bid has been completed and is attached.

There are no outstanding complaints or challenges in place.

### Postgraduates

Of the Postgraduates left in place on the announcement of the closure of the School, all were offered new supervision under existing staff, although three remained with their original supervisors.

Two students both successfully gained their PhDs, while three have completed their MA theses to the satisfaction of examiners.

Of the remaining three postgraduates, one is due to submit in September 2014, one is considering an intercalation - currently due to submit in September 2015 - and one is considering resubmitting his thesis in 2015. A support package, agreed with the PGR office, is in place if these students decide to continue their studies at UEA.
