Fellowships

1. Diabetes UK

DEADLINE BROUGHT FORWARD: RD Lawrence fellowship

This fellowship enables postdoctoral researchers to establish their independence in diabetes research. The fellowship is worth up to £525,000 over five years. ***

Deadline: 31-Oct-20. Applications are invited between April and 30 October each year. Deadlines on: 30 October 2020, and repeated annually.

1. Eastern ARC Fund

Eastern ARC (Universities of East Anglia, Essex and Kent) has set up the Eastern ARC Fund to support collaboration between two or more of the partner universities in meeting the UN's Sustainable Development Goals. Eligible activity includes: pilot projects; visits and exchanges; workshops, sandpits and other events.

Awards up to £2K, £5K or £10K depending on activity
