We have now considered your request of 30 September 2015 for the following information:

1. Has your institution received representations from any organisation requesting or suggesting that medical students be contacted by the medical school regarding the proposed new Junior Doctor's Contract? If so, please supply the text of any correspondence in relation to this matter including the minutes of any meetings at which this was discussed.

2. Have medical students at your institution been sent correspondence (written or electronic mail) by the medical school in relation to the proposed new Junior Doctors' Contract? If so, please supply;

- the text of any such correspondence (including the identity of the signatory or signatories)*
- any written communication relating to how this correspondence was drafted including the minutes of any meetings at which this was discussed*
- the name of any organisation or organisations external to the University involved in the drafting of this correspondence*

On this occasion it is not possible to provide the requested information. In line with your rights under section 1(1)(a) of the Act to be informed whether information is held, we confirm that with regard to question 1, the University has received no such representations and therefore holds no correspondence or related minutes.

We can also confirm the University's medical students have not been sent any correspondence relating to the proposed new Junior Doctors' Contract by the Norwich Medical School. We therefore hold no information in response to question 2.

We hope this response meets your requirements, however you have the right of appeal against this response. If you wish to appeal, please set out in writing your reasons for appealing and send to the above address. You must appeal within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. Any appeal received after that date will not be considered nor acknowledged. This policy has been reviewed and approved by the Information Commissioner's Office.
