'...could I have graduate retention numbers within Greater Norwich, current sectors graduates work within after leaving UEA, how many students get graduate jobs after graduation...'

Clarification received on 30/11:

The data provided should:

- Be the most recent available.
- Include information on which are the biggest UEA Schools in terms of student numbers.

'Greater Norwich' = Broadland, Norwich City Council and South Norfolk.

Response:

Please note, our reporting software does not hold data by district councils, therefore we have provided data for Norfolk and East of England, rather than 'Greater Norwich'.

Employment status of UEA leavers of 2013/14 after six months (data from DLHE survey¹ data gathered for 2013/14 leavers six months after graduation):
