Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Information request (ref: FOI_15-104)

In our response to question 1 of your information request of 14 May 2015 (ref: FOI_15-092), we provided the following information:

Question: *1) How many such "non-settled" students, who are residents of the UK but currently do not have settled status, i.e. having limited leave to remain with extensions every 2.5 years or discretionary to remain with extensions every 3 years (not British citizens, persons with indefinite leave to enter or remain, or other international students with a student tier 4 visa) are on Medicine course at your University in the year 1 and 2?*

Response: Year 1: 11
 Year 2: 13

In your email of 02 June you asked the following question, which we consider to be a new request for information. As such, we have logged this request separately with the reference provided above.

'You answered that you have 11 students in year 1 and 13 international student in year 2. I would like to know how many of these students are classed as overseas for fee purposes only but do have domicile in the UK upon admission. (Those who lived in the UK on the point of admission but were not granted home fees because they did not meet settlement criteria).'

We can confirm that there was one student in year 1 and no students in year 2 that met this criteria.

We hope this information meets your requirements, however you have the right of appeal against this response. If you wish to appeal, please set out in writing your reasons for appealing and send to the above address. You must appeal within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. Any appeal received after that date will not be considered nor acknowledged. This policy has been reviewed and approved by the Information Commissioner's Office.
