I am looking to find out how many students are successful in their application but defer their entry, consequently this is my request:

I would like to know the total amount of successful applicants who chose to defer their entry in the last three years.

To clarify, applicants who defer their entry are those who achieve their grades but then decide to delay coming to the university for a year.

The requested information is presented within the table below:
