### **Issue**

The University has run a successful Teaching Fellowship scheme for a number of years, fully funded by funding provided through HEFCE TESS monies. The HEFCE funding has now ceased and consequently the University will be terminating the scheme with immediate effect. It had been possible to use remaining monies to fund the scheme in 2013-14, but there are now insufficient funds to allow its continuation into 2014-15.
