“Introductory Mathematics for Economists

Agreed (17)

that the unit content should be reviewed and redesigned in consultation with the Introductory unit teachers with a view to starting the content at a higher level and to prepare students for economic applications. **ACTION: SL,SC**

Agreed (18)

that there should be separate seminars groups for those with and without a-level maths and that the following option for the lecture provision should be introduced

and that students with A-level maths should be required to take the redesigned unit from Autumn 2006.”
