I am making a request regarding general statistics for the A100 UCAS cycle.

This request is for the 2012/2013 and for the 2011/2012 cycle. How many students that are called for interview are international students?

Fifty-six (56) international applicants¹ were interviewed in 2012 for the 2012/13 UCAS cycle and fifty-nine (59) international applicants were interviewed in 2011 for the 2011/12 UCAS cycle.
